### GENERAL INFORMATION

- 50% deposit is required to confirm a booking, *unless other arrangements are made.*
- Balance to be paid in full in cash or T/Checks upon completion of Safari, unless other arrangements are made.
- Rifles are available for hire @ \$30 per day, plus any ammunition used.
- Safaris to other destinations are available on request for other species, as well as big five.

### ALL PRICES INCLUDE:

- All accommodation, meals, soft drink, wine, beer and daily laundry. (Hard liquor not included.)
- Services of a licensed professional hunter or Guide.
- Use of a hunting vehicle.
- Collection and return to nearest airport. ( SA only)
- Field preparation of trophies.
- Delivery to local taxidermist or dip and pack agent. ( SA only)
- Licenses. ( SA only)

### ALL PRICES EXCLUDE:

- Taxidermy, or dip and pack fees.
- Airfares and charters
- Hotel or accommodation costs before or after safari
- Items of a personal nature
- All insurance costs – personal, cancellation and travel insurance recommended to be taken before departure from home.
- Gratuities to all guides, Professional hunters, trackers, skinners and camp staff. These gratuities are considered normal, and are greatly appreciated by all concerned
- VAT Tax at 14% of daily rates.

### TROPHY HUNTING FOR 2012

- These prices are for trophy hunting in the Eastern Cape of South Africa.
- Hunts in other provinces can be arranged, but will be quoted separately.
- Big "Dangerous" game hunts are also offered in different areas and will also be quoted according to the area and animals required.

Daily rates : 1x1 \$ 425 per hunter per day.  
2x1 \$ 380 per hunter per day.  
\$ 200 per day for observers.

\* The animals marked with an astrix (\*) are found in limited numbers or require special permits and should be reserved in advance. All rock hyrax, hares, springhares, porcupine etc \$100, unless quoted a different price.

**TOURS AND HUNT/TOUR CONBINATIONS:**

- Any tour or hunt/tour combination can be made up according to the clients needs. ( for example: 6 days of hunting and 6 days touring).
- Hunting days are charged at \$ 425 per hunter and \$ 200 per non-hunter.
- Touring days are charged at \$ 400 per person.

**TERMS :**

- All prices are quoted in US Dollars.
- A 50 % deposit of the daily rate will secure a booking.
- Deposits secure a booking of a particular year and date, and not necessarily the prices of the year the deposit was made.

**The prices are subject to change without notice.**

- The balance of payments are to made in full at the end of the safari.
- Payments are to be made in either cash or travelers checks or direct bank transfers.
- Daily rates are charged per hunting day and not per night in camp.
- Trophy fees are payable on all animals killed or wounded and must be paid before departure from the hunting camp.

**CANCELLATIONS:**

- The deposit serves as confirmation of the agreement and arrangements between the client and outfitter.
- Cancellations are to be made in writing.
- Deposits are only refundable if the safari is cancelled at least twelve months before the start date of the safari. An alternate date for the safari can also be arranged between the client and outfitter.
